On behalf of FEIF and NSIJP, we would like to invite you to the Netherlands for the fourth FEIF Young Leaders' seminar. FEIF Youth work is offering a series of annual seminars, focussing on the age group 18-26 when great changes take place in the lives of young people. We aim to develop and practice skills on leadership in relation to others, and also in relation to our horses. How do I build a team? What is the difference between teamwork and partnership? How do I practice communication at a higher level?

The event is part-theoretical and part-practical, and you do not need to bring your own horse. Places are limited, and the maximum number of participants is 35.

Age group: 18 – 26 years. (Eligible are young people who are no younger than 18, and no older than 26 at the time of the seminar)

Registration is only possible via your national association (it is not possible to register without confirmation from the national youth leader). Until **September 20th, 2019**, each country can apply for only 2 places but may add further names on a waiting list.

Organisation: Stella Timmerman, NSIJP, Gundula Sharman, FEIF Director of Youth Work, and the FEIF Youth Committee.

Venue: Groepsaccommodatie Broekackers, Noordvelderweg 5, 1935 BP, Binnen-Egmond

Programme: The seminar will start Fri, 22nd November, 16:30 at Groepsaccommodatie Broekackers and ends Sun 24th November, right after lunch

Travel: From Schiphol Airport, you can take the train and the bus to get to the location. First, you take the train from Schiphol Airport to Amsterdam Sloterdijk Station. From there, you take another train to Heiloo Station. The last part of the journey will be by bus (bus 408) to bus stop Dorpshuis, Egmond-Binnen. From there, it's an eight minute walk to the location. We will make sure there's someone at Schiphol Airport to help you with the train tickets. There won't be any buses available on Sunday. You can travel by taxi to either the train station or Schiphol itself instead. You can plan your travel by public transportation with www.9292.nl

Cost: Cost, including full board and accommodation (alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages are not included) for the seminar is €220.-

The early bird price is €200, if registration and payment is received before September 10th, 2019
